SOMERVELL COUNTY INDIGENT CARE AFFILIATION AGREEMENT

This Indigent Care Affiliation Agreement (the "Agreement") is entered into as of the date of final execution and effective as of June 30, 2011, by and between Somervell County Hospital Authority (the "Hospital Authority"), dba Glen Rose Medical Center (the "Medical Center"), Somervell County, Texas ("County"), and Baylor University Medical Center, a Texas non-profit corporation (the "Affiliated Hospital").

RECITALS

- A. The Affiliated Hospital and the Hospital Authority through the Medical Center together annually furnish a significant percentage of the total uncompensated care provided to indigent residents of the County.
- B. As a result of reductions in Medicaid spending and a growing uninsured population, the amount of uncompensated indigent care provided by hospitals in the County will continue to increase.
- C. The Hospital Authority is authorized and desires to provide, or arrange for the provision of, medical aid, hospital care, and other health care services to indigent and needy persons residing in the County or accessing care through the Hospital Authority's health care facilities.
- D. The Affiliated Hospital, the Hospital Authority, and the County recognize a need to support their mutual interest in addressing indigent care issues in the County to ensure the continued viability of the community's Medicaid providers.
- E. The Affiliated Hospital, the Hospital Authority, and the County recognize that it is in their mutual best interest to increase funding for the Medicaid population, consistent with applicable federal and state requirements, and to access local and federal funding to which the Affiliated Hospital is entitled under Medicaid supplemental payment principles.
- F. The Affiliated Hospital, the Hospital Authority, and the County intend this Agreement to fulfill the requirements for participation in the Medicaid supplemental payment program authorized by Medicaid State Plan Amendment TX-05-011 and to comply with the requirements for supplemental payments to private hospitals currently codified at 1 Texas Administrative Code § 355.8070, as hereinafter may be amended.

In consideration of the premises, and the mutual promises and covenants contained in this Agreement, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which are hereby acknowledged and agreed, the parties agree as follows:

1.0 DEFINITIONS.

- 1.1 "Effective Date" shall be June 30, 2011.
- 1.2 "Charity Care" means the provision of hospital services to the uninsured, as well as services defined by Texas Health and Safety Code § 311.031(2).



- 1.3 "Somervell County UPL" means the Somervell County Medicaid supplemental payment program developed in Somervell County, Texas, pursuant to Medicaid State Plan Amendment TX-05-011.
- 1.4 "Days" means calendar days unless otherwise specified.
- 1.5 "Indigent(s)" means any person who meets the income guidelines, or other guidelines related to indigent status, established for participation in the Texas Medicaid program, Children's Health Insurance Program ("CHIP"), Hospital Authority Charity Care program, County Charity Care program, or Affiliated Hospital Charity Care program.
- 1.6 "Indigent Care" means treatment, services and education concerning the inpatient and outpatient hospital and medical professional needs of the Indigent, including both the performance of services and the provision for services.
- 1.7 "State Fiscal Year" means the twelve-month period beginning October 1 and ending September 30.
- 1.8 "Supplemental Payment(s)" means funds received by the Affiliated Hospital pursuant to either or both Section (t) of Attachment 4.19-A and Section (8) of Attachment 4.19-B of the Texas Medicaid State Plan and pursuant to the State regulations currently codified at 1 Texas Administrative Code § 355.8070, as hereinafter may be amended.

2.0 REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES.

- 2.1 Representations and Warranties of the Affiliated Hospital. The Affiliated Hospital represents and warrants the following:
 - a. It is a Texas non-profit corporation, duly established and created pursuant to applicable law with all requisite power and authority to enter into this Agreement.
 - b. It is a private hospital as currently defined at 1 Texas Administrative Code § 355.8070(b)(10).
 - c. No part of any Supplemental Payment received by the Affiliated Hospital will be returned or reimbursed to either the Hospital Authority or the County.
 - d. The Affiliated Hospital will not use any other funds to reimburse either the Hospital Authority or the County in consideration of any Supplemental Payments made to the Affiliated Hospital.
 - e. The Affiliated Hospital will not use any Supplemental Payment or part thereof to pay a contingent fee, consulting fee, or legal fee, associated with the Affiliated Hospital's receipt of Supplemental Payments.

- f. The Affiliated Hospital has not entered into and will not enter into any agreement with either the Hospital Authority or the County to condition either the amount of any public funds that may be transferred by the County to the Texas Health and Human Services Commission (“HHSC”) or the amount of any Supplemental Payments the Affiliated Hospital may receive on the amount of Indigent Care the Affiliated Hospital has provided or will provide.
- g. The Affiliated Hospital has not entered into and will not enter into any agreement with either the Hospital Authority or the County to condition the amount of the Affiliated Hospital’s Indigent Care obligation on either the amount of any public funds that may be transferred by the County to HHSC or the amount of any Supplemental Payments the Affiliated Hospital may be eligible to receive.
- h. Neither the County nor the Hospital Authority has received and will not receive refunds of payments the County made or makes to the Affiliated Hospital for any purpose in consideration for an intergovernmental transfer (“IGT”) by the County to fund the Supplemental Payments.
- i. The execution, delivery, and performance by the Affiliated Hospital of this Agreement are within the Affiliated Hospital’s powers, are not in contravention of any other instruments governing the Affiliated Hospital, and have been duly authorized and approved by its governance as and to the extent required by applicable law.
- j. Neither the Affiliated Hospital, nor any of its representatives are (i) currently excluded, debarred, or otherwise ineligible to participate in the Federal health care programs as defined in 42 U.S.C. § 1320a-7b(f) (the “Federal Health Care Programs”); or (ii) convicted of a criminal offense related to the provision of health care items or services but not yet excluded, debarred, or otherwise declared ineligible to participate in the Federal Health Care Programs.
- k. This Agreement has been duly and validly executed and delivered by the Affiliated Hospital or its authorized agent and constitutes the valid, legal, and binding obligation of the Affiliated Hospital, enforceable against the Affiliated Hospital in accordance with its terms.

2.2 Representations and Warranties of the Hospital Authority. The Hospital Authority represents and warrants the following:

- a. It is a political subdivision of the State of Texas, duly established and created pursuant to the Texas Constitution with all requisite power and authority to enter into this Agreement.
- b. The execution, delivery, and performance by the Hospital Authority of this Agreement are within the Hospital Authority’s powers, are not in

contravention of any other instruments governing the Hospital Authority, and have been duly authorized and approved by its Board of Directors in a public meeting preceded by public notice published in accordance with the Hospital Authority's usual and customary practices or the Texas Open Meetings Act, as applicable.

- c. Neither the Hospital Authority nor any of its representatives are (i) currently excluded, debarred, or otherwise ineligible to participate in the Federal Health Care Programs; or (ii) convicted of a criminal offense related to the provision of health care items or services but not yet excluded, debarred, or otherwise declared ineligible to participate in those programs.
- d. This Agreement has been duly and validly executed and delivered by the Hospital Authority and constitutes the valid, legal, and binding obligation of the Hospital Authority, enforceable against the Hospital Authority in accordance with its terms.
- e. The Hospital Authority has not received and has no agreement to receive any portion of any Supplemental Payments that may be made by HHSC to the Affiliated Hospital.
- f. The Hospital Authority has not entered into a contingent fee arrangement related to its participation in the Somervell County UPL.
- g. To the Hospital Authority's knowledge, there is not and will be no agreement to condition either the amount of any public funds that may be transferred by the County to HHSC or the amount of any Supplemental Payments the Affiliated Hospital may receive on the amount of Indigent Care the Affiliated Hospital has provided or will provide.
- h. To the Hospital Authority's knowledge, there is not and will be no agreement to condition the amount of the Affiliated Hospital's Indigent Care obligation on either the amount of any public funds that may be transferred by the County to HHSC or the amount of any Supplemental Payments the Affiliated Hospital may be eligible to receive.
- i. The Hospital Authority has not received and will not receive refunds of any payments the County makes to the Affiliated Hospital for any purpose in consideration for an IGT by the County to fund the Supplemental Payments.

2.3 Representations and Warranties of the County. The County represents and warrants the following:

- a. It is a political subdivision of the State of Texas, duly established and created pursuant to the Texas Constitution with all requisite power and authority to enter into this Agreement.

- b. The execution, delivery, and performance by the County of this Agreement are within the County's powers, are not in contravention of any other instruments governing the County, and have been duly authorized and approved by its Board of Managers, as and to the extent required by applicable law.
- c. Neither the County nor any of its representatives are: (i) currently excluded, debarred, or otherwise ineligible to participate in the Federal Health Care Programs; or (ii) convicted of a criminal offense related to the provision of health care items or services but not yet excluded, debarred, or otherwise declared ineligible to participate in those programs.
- d. This Agreement has been duly and validly executed and delivered by the County and constitutes the valid, legal, and binding obligation of the County, enforceable against the County in accordance with its terms.
- e. The County has not received and has no agreement to receive any portion of any Supplemental Payments that may be made by HHSC to the Affiliated Hospital.
- f. The County has not entered into a contingent fee arrangement related to its participation in the Somervell County UPL.
- g. There is not and will be no agreement to condition either the amount of any public funds that may be transferred by the County to HHSC or the amount of any Supplemental Payments the Affiliated Hospital may receive on the amount of Indigent Care the Affiliated Hospital has provided or will provide.
- h. There is not and will be no agreement to condition the amount of the Affiliated Hospital's Indigent Care obligation on either the amount of any public funds that may be transferred by the County to HHSC or the amount of any Supplemental Payments the Affiliated Hospital may be eligible to receive.
- i. The County has not received and will not receive refunds of any payments the County makes to the Affiliated Hospital for any purpose in consideration for an IGT by the County to fund the Supplemental Payments.

3.0 OBLIGATIONS OF THE AFFILIATED HOSPITAL.

- 3.1 **Agreement to Cooperate.** The Affiliated Hospital agrees to work cooperatively with the Hospital Authority and the County to improve access, availability, efficiency, delivery, and funding for health care services provided to the County's indigent.

- 3.2 **Compliance with State and Federal Law.** The Affiliated Hospital agrees to ensure that Indigent Care that it provides pursuant to this Agreement is provided in compliance with applicable state and federal laws and with requirements for participation in the Medicaid program.
- 3.3 **Compliance with HIPAA Requirements.** To the extent applicable to this Agreement, the Affiliated Hospital agrees to comply with the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996, as codified at 42 U.S.C. § 1320d et seq. (“HIPAA”), as amended by the Health Information Technology for Economic and Clinical Health Act, and any current and future regulations promulgated thereunder, including, without limitation, the federal privacy regulations contained in 45 C.F.R. Parts 160 and 164 (the “Federal Privacy Regulations”), the federal security standards contained in 45 C.F.R. Parts 160, 162 and 164 (the “Federal Security Regulations”), and the federal standards for electronic transactions contained in 45 C.F.R. Parts 160 and 162 (The “Federal Electronic Transaction Regulations”), all as amended from time to time and all collectively referred to herein as “HIPAA Requirements,” including implementing administrative, physical and technical safeguards that reasonably and appropriately protect the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of any electronic Protection Health Information created, maintained, or transmitted in that capacity. The Affiliated Hospital agrees that any use, disclosure or request of Protected Health Information by the Affiliated Hospital shall be limited, to the extent practicable, to the limited data set, as that term is defined under the HIPAA Requirements, or to the minimum necessary to accomplish the intended purposes of such use, disclosure, or request, respectively. In the event that the Affiliated Hospital discovers a breach of Protected Health Information, the Affiliated Hospital shall provide notice of such breach to the Hospital Authority in compliance with requirements pertaining to the provision of notice by covered entities as set forth in the HIPAA Requirements. In addition, the Affiliated Hospital agrees to comply with any state laws and regulations that govern or pertain to the confidentiality, privacy, security of, and electronic transactions pertaining to health care information.
- 3.4 **Access to Records.** To the extent required by law, upon the written request of the Secretary of Health and Human Services, the Comptroller General or any of their duly authorized representatives, the Affiliated Hospital shall make available those contracts, books, documents and records necessary to verify the nature and extent of the costs of providing services under this Agreement. Such inspection shall be available for up to four (4) years after the rendering of such services. If the Affiliated Hospital carries out any of the duties of this Agreement through a subcontract (if permitted) with a value of \$10,000.00 or more over a twelve (12) month period with a related individual or organization, the Affiliated Hospital agrees to include this requirement in any such subcontract. This section is included pursuant to and is governed by the requirement of 42 U.S.C. § 1395x(v)(1) and the regulations thereto.

4.0 OBLIGATIONS OF THE HOSPITAL AUTHORITY.

- 4.1 **Agreement to Cooperate with the Affiliated Hospital and the County.** The Hospital Authority agrees to work cooperatively with the Affiliated Hospital and the County to improve access, availability, efficiency, delivery, and funding for Indigent Care provided to the County's Indigent.
- 4.2 **Compliance with State and Federal Law.** The Hospital Authority agrees to ensure that Indigent Care that it provides pursuant to this Agreement is provided in compliance with applicable state and federal laws and with requirements for participation in the Medicaid program.
- 4.3 **Provision of Indigent Care.** As a condition of affiliation, the Hospital Authority agrees to meet the requirements, including those regarding Indigent Care, as otherwise mutually agreed by the parties from time to time to carry out the purposes of this Agreement.
- 4.4 **Compliance with HIPAA Requirements.** To the extent applicable to this Agreement, the Hospital Authority agrees to comply with the HIPAA Requirements, including implementing, administrative, physical and technical safeguards that reasonably and appropriately protect the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of any electronic Protected Health Information created, maintained, or transmitted in that capacity. The Hospital Authority agrees that any use, disclosure or request of Protected Health Information by the Hospital Authority shall be limited, to the extent practicable, to the limited data set, as that term is defined under the HIPAA Requirements, or to the minimum necessary to accomplish the intended purpose of such use, disclosure, or request, respectively. In the event that the Hospital Authority discovers a breach of Protected Health Information, the Hospital Authority shall provide notice of such breach to the other parties in compliance with the requirements pertaining to the provision of notice by covered entities as set forth in the HIPAA Requirements. In addition, the Hospital Authority agrees to comply with any state laws and regulations that govern or pertain to the confidentiality, privacy, security of, and electronic transactions pertaining to health care information.
- 4.5 **Access to Records.** As and to the extent required by law, upon the written request of the Secretary of Health and Human Services, the Comptroller General or any of their duly authorized representatives, the Hospital Authority shall make available those contracts, books, documents and records necessary to verify the nature and extent of the costs of providing services under this Agreement. Such inspection shall be available for up to four (4) years after the rendering of such services. If the Hospital Authority carries out any of the duties of this Agreement through a subcontract (if permitted) with a value of \$10,000.00 or more over a twelve (12) month period with a related individual or organization, the Hospital Authority agrees to include this requirement in any such subcontract. This section is included pursuant to and is governed by the requirement of 42 U.S.C. § 1395x(v)(1) and the regulations thereto.

5.0 OBLIGATIONS OF THE COUNTY.

- 5.1 **Agreement to Cooperate with the Affiliated Hospital and the Hospital Authority.** The County agrees to work cooperatively with the Affiliated Hospital and the Hospital Authority to improve access, availability, efficiency, delivery, and funding for Indigent Care provided to the County's Indigent.
- 5.2 **Compliance with State and Federal Law.** The County agrees to ensure that its actions under this Agreement are in compliance with applicable state and federal laws and with requirements.
- 5.3 **Provision of Indigent Care.** As a condition of affiliation, the County agrees to meet the requirements, including those regarding Indigent Care, as otherwise mutually agreed by the parties from time to time to carry out the purposes of this Agreement.
- 5.4 **Compliance with HIPAA Requirements.** To the extent applicable to this Agreement and to the County, the County agrees to comply with the HIPAA Requirements, including implementing, administrative, physical and technical safeguards that reasonably and appropriately protect the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of any electronic Protected Health Information created, maintained, or transmitted in that capacity. The County agrees that any use, disclosure or request of Protected Health Information by the County shall be limited, to the extent practicable, to the limited data set, as that term is defined under the HIPAA Requirements, or to the minimum necessary to accomplish the intended purpose of such use, disclosure, or request, respectively. In the event that the County discovers a breach of Protected Health Information, the County shall provide notice of such breach to the other parties in compliance with the requirements pertaining to the provision of notice by covered entities as set forth in the HIPAA Requirements. In addition, the County agrees to comply with any state laws and regulations that govern or pertain to the confidentiality, privacy, security of, and electronic transactions pertaining to health care information.
- 5.5 **Funding Non-Federal Share of Somervell County UPL.** The County agrees to consider submitting to the State of Texas periodic IGTs as the non-federal share of payments for Medicaid services under the Somervell County UPL in amounts, if any, determined appropriate by the County, in its sole discretion, and to report to the Hospital Authority and the Affiliated Hospital the amount submitted. The County agrees it will not condition the amount to which it funds the non-federal share of Supplemental Payments on a specified or required minimum amount of prospective Indigent Care. The County agrees to take reasonable efforts to obtain annual budget authority for these IGTs.
- 5.6 **Use of County Indigent Care Funds.** To the extent the County decides to provide funding for the Medicaid private hospital supplemental payment program, the County agrees to use its indigent funds for such funding.

6.0 GENERAL PROVISIONS.

6.1 Term and Termination.

- a. The initial term of this Agreement shall be from its Effective Date until September 30, 2012, unless terminated earlier in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement. The Agreement may be extended for additional terms of one (1) year each under the same terms and conditions unless amended pursuant to Section 6.11, provided all parties notify each other in writing on or before thirty (30) days prior to the end of the then-current term of their consent to extension of the Agreement for another one (1) year term.
- b. This Agreement may be terminated by any party at any time without cause upon at least thirty (30) days written notice to the other parties. Termination under this Section 6.1(b) shall be effective as of the date specified in the notice.
- c. This Agreement may be terminated upon the breach of any material term or condition of this Agreement by the Hospital Authority or the County if such breach is not corrected within fifteen (15) days after written notice thereof to the Hospital Authority or the County from the Affiliated Hospital. This Agreement may be terminated upon the breach of any material term or condition of this Agreement by the Affiliated Hospital if such breach is not corrected within fifteen (15) days after written notice thereof to the Affiliated Hospital from the Hospital Authority or the County.
- d. This Agreement may also be terminated pursuant to Section 6.2 or in the event the United States government ceases to recognize the Medicaid private hospital supplemental payment program contemplated by this Agreement.

6.2 Compliance with Law. If any provision of this Agreement or any action by any party as contemplated herein is determined by the federal or state government, by a court of law, or pursuant to a formal legal opinion provided by counsel to a party to this Agreement, to be in violation of a federal or state law or regulation, including but not limited to the federal Medicaid intergovernmental transfer requirements or the State Plan Amendment TX-05-011 or other state Medicaid requirements, or there is a change in any federal or state law or regulation or federal or state agency interpretation thereof that adversely affects this Agreement or the actions of any party under this Agreement, then except as otherwise provided herein any party may by notice to the other parties propose a new basis for continuation of this Agreement. If such notice of new basis is given and the parties are unable within thirty (30) days thereafter to agree upon a new basis for continuation of this Agreement, any party may terminate this Agreement without penalty effective upon receipt of written notice by the other parties. If any determination or change referred to above is effective immediately, any party may

terminate this Agreement without penalty, effective upon actual or constructive receipt by the other parties of written notice of termination.

- 6.3 **Notices.** All notices to be given under this Agreement shall be in writing and may be personally delivered or may be given by United States mail or overnight carrier addressed to the parties as follows:

All notices shall be deemed to be effective upon receipt if by personal delivery, three (3) business days after deposit in the United States mail, or one (1) business day after delivery to carrier if by overnight carrier.

- 6.4 **Relationships Between the Parties.** Each party to this Agreement is an independent contractor and not an agent, servant, joint enterprise, or employee as to the other parties to the Agreement and unless otherwise specified in this Agreement or another agreement is responsible for its own acts, omissions, forbearance, negligence and deeds, and for those of its agents or employees in conjunction with the performance of services covered under this Agreement, and shall be specifically responsible for sufficient supervision and inspection to ensure compliance in every respect with the Agreement requirements. There shall be no contractual relationship between any subcontractor, agent, employee or supplier of the Affiliated Hospital, the Hospital Authority, or the County by virtue of this Agreement.
- 6.5 **Governing Law.** This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Texas. This Agreement is performable and enforceable in Somervell County, Texas where the principal offices of the Hospital Authority and County are located, and the state or federal courts in the County shall be the sole and exclusive venue for any litigation, special proceeding, or other proceeding as between the parties that may be brought, or arise out of, in connection with, or by reason of this Agreement. Affiliated Hospital understands that the Hospital Authority is a political subdivision of the State of Texas and governed by certain applicable statutes and the County is a unit of local government and governed by certain applicable statutes.
- 6.6 **Assignment or Subcontract.** No party may assign or subcontract any right, obligation, or responsibility under this Agreement except to a successor in interest without the prior written consent of the other parties.
- 6.7 **No Third Party Beneficiary.** This Agreement does not confer any right or benefit on any third party and may be enforced solely by the parties.
- 6.8 **Articles and Other Headings.** The division of this Agreement into articles and sections, and the use of captions and headings, are solely for convenience of reference, and shall have no legal effect in construing the provisions of this Agreement or in governing the rights, obligations, or liabilities of the parties.
- 6.9 **Effect of Agreement.** This Agreement, any amendments, and any exhibits specifically mentioned in the Agreement supersede all prior or contemporaneous discussions, representations, correspondence, memoranda and agreements, whether oral or written, pertaining to the provision of Indigent Care to County Indigent by the parties.

6.10 **Multiple Originals.** This Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts with multiple signature pages, each fully executed copy shall be deemed an original, and all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

6.11 **Amendment or Modification.** This Agreement may only be amended or modified in writing by the mutual agreement of all parties hereto.







DRAFT Local Health Authority Functions

Qualifications

- Competent physician with a reputable professional standing who is legally qualified to practice medicine in this state
- Resident of the state

Term of Office

- The Local Health Authority (LHA) term of office is two years
- The LHA may continue to serve additional terms if reappointed by the governing body. If reappointed, the appropriate forms must again be signed and submitted to the appropriate agencies.

Expected LHA Duties of those counties not served by a local health department:

- Support the responsible DSHS Regional Office to establish, maintain and enforce control measures regarding communicable or infectious diseases.
- Ensure the reporting of the presence of contagious, infectious and dangerous epidemic diseases to the responsible DSHS Regional office.
- Based on the scope of locally provided environmental health services, enforce state and local public health laws, rules, requirements and ordinances regarding sanitation and control measures.
- Ensure local adherence to state law regarding vital statistics collections including accuracy of birth and death records in their jurisdiction.
- Arrange for or carry out local court ordered testing for STD/HIV of persons accused of certain offenses.
- Perform post-exposure evaluation for persons exposed to blood-borne pathogens.

Optional LHA Duties of those counties not served by a local health department:

- Act as a liaison between the local elected officials, local medical community and the responsible DSHS Regional Office during investigations of food-borne or disease outbreaks and responses to natural disasters.
- Respond to questions or concerns about public health issues/threats from local elected officials, community leaders, or community groups/coalitions.
- Prepare/disseminate public health information such as DSHS or CDC health alerts regarding outbreaks and public health threats to the medical community.
- Inform the community including local elected officials, medical community and general public about public health concerns/threats.
- Engage in health planning and/or disaster planning for the community.
- Inform/educate the community including local elected officials and the medical community about the importance of reporting contagious and infectious communicable diseases to the responsible DSHS Regional Office.

Benefits of Local Health Authority

- Local qualified physician to assist elected officials, providers and citizens with public health questions/issues.
- Local authority has knowledge of the community and its' resources.
- Local authority has knowledge of the community's citizens.
- Local authority has knowledge of the community's challenges.
- Local authority who has an investment in the community.
- Local physician provides an efficient, immediate response to any public health issue. (Texas Department of State Health Services Regional office is located in Arlington).
- Local authority to act as a liaison between local elected officials, local medical community and Texas Department of State Health Services.
