DISCUSSION ON AGENDA ITEMS

1. County Judge: Receive the Funding Plan for the Preservation and Restoration of the County and District Clerk's Records Archives.

Candace Garrett, County/District Clerk gave an overview of the Somervell County/District Clerk 2013-14 Records Management and Archive Plan. She presented to the Commissioners' Court the background, bill summaries, purpose, goals, annual revenue estimate, archive projects, microfilm library assessment services, and equipment. She also went over House Bill (HB) 1513 due to the increases that affect the Records Archive Fee, Records Management and Preservation Fee, and the District Court Technology Archive Fee.

HB 1513 increases both the maximum Record Archive Fee and Records Management and Preservation Fee from \$5 to \$10 effective 9/01/13. The increase for the Records Archive fee and the Records Management and Preservation fee will expire 9/01/2019 and the \$10 will revert back to \$5.

HB 1513 increases the maximum District Court Technology Archive Fee from \$5 to \$10 effective 1-1-14. The increase for the District Court Technology Archive Fee will expire 9/01/2019 and the \$10 will revert back to \$5.
